

Tina Kelly (Director) A native Charlottean, Tina Kelly is the epitome of home grown talent. Graduating from UNC-Charlotte with a BA in Theater, she has always thought of herself as a theater maker. Starting with assistant stage managing with Actors Theater Charlotte and Children's Theater Charlotte, moving to stage managing for the likes of Three Bone Theatre and OnQ productions and many others, Tina has made it her mission to align herself with any and all theater in Charlotte.

Continuing in theater administration and producing at Queen City New Play Initiative, Tina has proven herself a jackie of all trades. .She's directed in theater festivals from Donna Scott Productions and Women's Theatre Festival. Chip Davis (Set Design) is thrilled to be returning to 3 Bone for his third production. Prior to Indiana, Chip was the Technical Director and in-house designer for Northwest School of the Arts as well as La Musica Lirica Opera. Chip currently serves as Technical Director for the Davidson College Theatre Department and Common Thread Theatre Collective where he teaches, builds, and designs. Recent projects include set design for MISS BENNET: CHRISTMAS AT PEMBERLEY at Davidson College Theatre, VIOLET and BARBEQUE at Common Thread Theatre, POTUS with Charlotte Conservatory Theatre, and ANDY AND THE ORPHANS with 3 Bone.

**Adriar Doward (Sound Design)** My name is Adrair Doward. I am one of the sound designers for THE GLORIOUS WORLD OF KINKS AND CURLS. This is my first time working with Three Bone Theatre, and i've enjoyed it so much!!

Bunny Gregory (Props Design) Michelle "Bunny" Gregory was born and raised in Charlotte, NC. She graduated with a degree in fashion illustration from the Art Institute of Fort Lauderdale, Florida. After her degree, she was the head of design for eight years at the special events firm, Creatrix. Accomplishments include: QC Family Tree - Culture Bearers Residency (2022); 2022 Creatives to Watch - Charlotte is Creative; Charlotte is Creative HUG Grant recipient (2021); McColl Center Teaching Artist (2021); Moving Poets Artist in Residency in Berlin, Germany (2010) and is currently a Pallet Table Artist with 9189 Studio Gallery at VAPA. She has been a collaborating artist with Moving Poets for theatre productions and youth outreach projects since 2000.

Growing up in the 70s and 80s, Bunny realized there weren't any venues for black artists to express themselves in Charlotte. Because of her love for hip hop and pop art, she opened her own venue, the UNDERGROUND, in 2014, which quickly became a staple platform for Charlotte-based urban artists, musicians, and poets. In 2017, Bunny was dubbed "Queen Mother of Charlotte's Underground Hip Hop" by Creative Loafing Magazine. Her current project is a "Harlem Renaissance" on wheels. This UNDERGROUND Mobile Art Studio and Gallery serve underserved youth in Charlotte communities. Her mixed-media studio work is heavily influenced by Afrocentric culture addressing issues of racial and economic disparity, and it often uses illustration, comic book-style drawings, pen and ink, and collage on salvaged boards. @ug\_battleofhearts

Bunny co-founded Mural Ninjas with lifelong friend and colleague MyLoan Dinh. **Keli Goff (Playwright)** is an internationally recognized multi-platform journalist and screenwriter, best known for chronicling the intersections of politics, pop culture, race and gender in America. In 2019, she was nominated for two Emmy

Awards for her work as a producer on the Netflix film REVERSING ROE, a documentary chronicling the history of America's political and legal battles over abortion.

As a journalist, Keli's work has appeared in some of the world's leading publications, including the magazines Time, Cosmopolitan and Essence, and the web editions of The New York Times, The Guardian, The Atlantic, Elle, Vogue, Glamour and New York Magazine among others. Before becoming a columnist at The Daily Beast in 2015, she previously served as a contributor to The Washington Post blog She the People, The Huffington Post and the online magazine The Root.

Keli's columns have sparked national conversations in a variety of media outlets, including The Wall Street Journal, and NBC's Meet the Press. She has appeared on more than 100 television and radio programs providing political analysis and cultural criticism on the networks CBS, MSNBC, NPR, FOX, BET, the BBC and many others. During the 2016 presidential election, she hosted Political Party with Keli Goff, a series of specials featuring interviews with politicians, media personalities and artists about the issues shaping the 2016 presidential election for NPR affiliate WNYC. She continues to contribute regularly to Left, Right & Center, airing on NPR affiliate KCRW.

In 2014 she also began writing for theater and television.

Known for her work in drama as well as comedy, in 2022 Keli became a writer and Co-Executive Producer on Taylor Sheridan's MAYOR OF KINGSTOWN following AND JUST LIKE THAT, the reboot of SEX AND THE CITY, on which Keli also worked as a writer and producer. Other television credits include JOE VS. CAROLE (a dramatization of the Tiger King saga), TWENTIES, and BLACK LIGHTNING, the CW series based on the DC Comics superhero. Before Black Lightning, she served on the writing staff of the critically acclaimed drama BEING MARY JANE, winning a 2016 NAACP Image Award for her work on the episode "Sparrow."

A recipient of the Public Theater's Emerging Writers Group Fellowship, Keli spent 2014-2016 developing new material at the legendary artistic institution best known for producing Shakespeare in the Park. In Spring 2021, Baltimore Center Stage began streaming the world premiere of her play, THE GLORIOUS WORLD OF CROWNS, KINKS AND CURLS, a celebration of black women's hair stories, to great acclaim.

Keli's first book, Party Crashing: How the Hip Hop Generation Declared Political Independence (Basic Books, March 2008) featured interviews with young voters and high profile leaders, including former Secretary of State Colin Powell and Civil Rights legend Julian Bond. The Washington Post called Party Crashing "engaging" while Arianna Huffington declared that it "Should be on the nightstand of candidates on either side of the political aisle."

She is currently working on her next documentary which is inspired by her collection of vintage clothing by historically significant designers of color. Selected pieces from Keli's vintage collection are currently housed at the Texas Fashion Collection and one was most recently included in the exhibit, "Delight: Selections from the Texas Fashion Collection" in 2022.

Born and raised in Texas, Keli now splits her time between Manhattan and Los Angeles. She holds a B.A. from New York University and a Master's degree in Strategic Communications from

# COMING SOON



In 1834, 16-year-old Afong Moy sailed into New York Harbor and was immediately put on display for a paying public who were mesmerized by her exotic ways and horrified by her tiny bound feet. Allegedly the first Chinese woman to set foot on U.S. soil, she has been put on display for the American public as "The Chinese Lady." For the next half-century, she performs for curious white people, showing them how she eats, what she wears, and the highlight of the event: how she walks with bound feet.
